In pursuance of Rule 5 (6) (ii) of Wetlands (Conservation and Management) Rules, 2017 issued by Government of India, the Governor of Haryana is pleased to constitute a "Grievance Committee" under Wetland Authority as a mechanism for hearing and forwarding the grievances raised by the public for wetlands falling under their respective jurisdiction. The Grievance Committee will consist of the following:-

1.	DC of respective district	Chairman
2.	Revenue Tehsildar of respective district	Member
3.	District Attorney of respective district	Member
4.	Representative from Development & Panchayats Department, Haryana	Member
5.	Representative from Irrigation and Water Resources Department, Haryana	Member Secretary

The Grievance Committee's functions, besides the directions/guidelines given, from time to time, will be:

1. To redress the grievances at the local level and to recommend to the Authority for the finality of decisions.
2. The meeting of this Committee for the cases referred to by the Wetland Authority shall be held at least once every quarter or earlier so as to comply with time limit or other guidelines, and proceedings presented in the next meeting of the Wetland Authority.
3. The Committee should consider the matters as per the provisions contained in the Wetlands (Conservation and Management) Rules, 2017.
