THE WEST BENGAL HOMOEOPATHIC SYSTEM OF  
MEDICINE (AMENDMENT) Act 1970.

*An Act to amend the West Bengal Homoeopathic System of Medicine Act, 1963.*

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the West Bengal Homoeopathic System of Medicine Act, 1963, for the purpose and in the manner hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted in the Twenty-first Year of the Republic of India, by the Legislature of West Bengal, as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the West Bengal Homoeopathic System of Medicine (Amendment) Act, 1970. Short title.

2. In section 21 of the West Bengal Homoeopathic System of Medicine Act, 1963, in the proviso to sub-section (2), for the words "within a period of two years from the date of commencement of this Act", the words and figures "on or before the 31st day of December, 1970" shall be substituted. Amend- ment of section 21 of West Ben. Act XXXIII of 1963.

3. (1) The West Bengal Homoeopathic System of Medicine (Amendment) Ordinance, 1969, is hereby repealed. Repeal and savings.

(2) Anything done or any action taken under the West Bengal Homoeopathic System of Medicine Act, 1963, as amended by the West Bengal Homoeopathic System of Medicine (Amendment) Ordinance, 1969, shall be deemed to have been validly done or taken under the said Act as amended by this Act as if this Act had commenced on the 12th day of December, 1969.
