WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the West Bengal Homoeopathic System of Medicine Act, 1963, for the purpose and in the manner hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted in the Twenty-ninth Year of the Republic of India, by the Legislature of West Bengal, as follows:—

<p>1. This Act may be called the West Bengal Homoeopathic System of Medicine (Second Amendment) Act, 1978.</p>	<p>Short title.</p>
<p>2. In section 15A of the West Bengal Homoeopathic System of Medicine Act, 1963, in sub-section (10), for the words “for a further period of six months”, the words “for a further period of eighteen months” shall be substituted and shall be deemed always to have been substituted.</p>
