WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Calcutta University Act, 1966, for the purpose and in the manner hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted in the Twenty-seventh Year of the Republic of India, by the Legislature of West Bengal, as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Calcutta University (Amendment) Act, 1976. Short title.

2. In section 8 of the Calcutta University Act, 1966 (hereinafter referred to as the said Act), for sub-section (1), the following sub-sections shall be substituted, namely:— Amendment of section 8 of West Ben. Act II of 1966.

"(1) The Vice-Chancellor shall be appointed by the Chancellor in consultation with the Minister from a panel of not less than three persons recommended by a Committee constituted for the purpose in the manner set forth in sub-section (1A):

Provided that no person shall be included in the panel without his consent.

(1A) The Committee referred to in sub-section (1) shall consist of five persons of whom two shall be nominees of the Syndicate, one shall be a nominee of the Academic Council, one shall be a nominee of the Chairman of the University Grants Commission and one shall be a nominee of the Chancellor who shall act as the Chairman of the Committee.

(1B) The Committee shall hold its meetings in accordance with such directions as may be issued by the Chancellor from time to time.

(1C) If the Chancellor does not approve of the persons included in the panel he may call for a fresh panel.

(1D) Subject to the provisions of the West Bengal University Laws Amendment (No. 2) Act, 1976, the Vice-Chancellor shall hold office for a term of four years and shall be eligible for re-appointment." West Ben. Act XXXI of 1976.

Repeal and savings.

3. (1) The Calcutta University (Second Amendment) Ordinance, 1976, is hereby repealed. West Ben. Ord. XIX of 1976.

(2) Anything done or any action taken under the said Act as amended by the Calcutta University (Second Amendment) Ordinance, 1976, shall be deemed to have been validly done or taken under the said Act as amended by this Act as if this Act had commenced on the 4th day of September, 1976.
