NATIONAL COUNCIL FOR TEACHER EDUCATION

New Delhi-110 002, the 13th December 1995

No. 28-9/95 NCTE.—In exercise of the powers conferred under clause (o) of sub-Section (2) of Section 32 read with sub-Section (7) of Section 20 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993, (No. 73 of 1993), the National Council for Teacher Education hereby makes the following regulations, namely:

1. Short title and Commencement

These regulations may be called the National Council for Teacher Education (establishment and territorial jurisdiction of Regional Committees) regulations, 1995. They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Definition

In these regulations unless the context otherwise requires:—

(i) "Act" means National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993 (No. 73 of 1993).

All other terms shall have same meaning as indicated in Section 2 of the Act.

3. Establishment of Regional Committees

Following Regional Committees shall be established:

- (i) the Eastern Regional Committee;
- (ii) the Western Regional Committee;
- (iii) the Northern Regional Committee and
- (iv) the Southern Regional Committee;

4. Territorial Jurisdiction

Regional Committees indicated in Regulation 3 shall cover the States/Union Territories as given below:
