WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the West Bengal Labour Welfare Fund Act, 1974, for the purpose and in the manner hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted in the Thirty-ninth Year of the Republic of India, by the Legislature of West Bengal, as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the West Bengal Labour Welfare Fund (Amendment) Act, 1988.

2. In clause (3) of section 2 of the West Bengal Labour Welfare Fund Act, 1974,—

- (a) after the words “in an establishment”, the words “, and includes a sales promotion employee” shall be inserted,
- (b) in sub-clause (b), for the words “seven hundred and fifty rupees”, the words “sixteen hundred rupees” shall be substituted, and
- (c) the following *Explanation* shall be added at the end:—

*‘Explanation.*—“Sales promotion employee” shall have the same meaning as in the Sales Promotion Employees (Conditions of Service) Act, 1976;’.
