WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the West Bengal Labour Welfare Fund Act, 1947, for the purpose and in the manner hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted in the Forty-eighth Year of the Republic of India, by the Legislature of West Bengal, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be called the West Bengal Labour Welfare Fund (Amendment) Act, 1947.

(2) It shall come into force on such date as the State Government may, by notification in the *Official Gazette*, appoint.

2. In section 9 of the West Bengal Labour Welfare Fund Act, 1974, for sub-section (2), the following sub-section shall be substituted:—

“(2) For each employee whose name stands on the register of an establishment,—

- (a) the employer’s contribution shall be two rupees, and
- (b) the employee’s contribution shall be one rupee, both payable every six months ending on the thirtieth day of June, and the thirty-first day of December, each year.”.
