No. ED. 3/58/99.—The Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to notify the conversion of Dibru Primary school to I.V. School in East Kameng district, as approved in A.O.P. 2001-2002 under Scheme No. 2 (Opening of I.V. Primary School).

Further, conversion of Dibru Primary School as stated above have been proposed to be established under following terms and conditions:—

1. 20 acres of land should be provided by the Community/Public free of cost for the entire school campus and for further expansion, land will be allotted/donated in writing by the competent authority/community in the name of Department of Education which will be duly counter-signed by the Deputy Commissioner of the District.

2. The boundary of the school campus should be well demarcated to avoid future dispute, encroachment etc.

3. The Community/Villagers of the locality should construct the school building and teachers quarter and hostel building on self help basis and should maintain the same for next three years.

4. The Department of Education will provide teachers and equipments etc, according to laid-down norms. The maintenance expenditure shall also be borne by the Department of Education.

5. The Department of Education will undertake construction of semi permanent/ permanent school building, teachers quarters, hostel etc. in a phased manner.

6. The amount required for providing approach road, water supply and electricity upto the campus shall be provided by P and D Department against the project and shall be placed at the disposal of PWD/Power Department before permanent construction starts.
